The System of Tourism Statistics


- ✓ Is part of the National Statistical System

- ✓ Operates at different territorial levels (national, federal, infra national, international)



Role of BoCTs

What we expect from Regional Bureau of Culture and Tourism

- Appointment of an employee responsible for the activities starting from today;
- 2. Appointment of an employee responsible for domestic survey and data entry starting from today;
- 3. Commitment in the engagement of local stakeholders;
- 4. Commitment in the survey on domestic tourism
- 5. Organization at the end of the consultancy:
 - one director/supervisor responsible for the system
 - one or more regional operator, data collector and data entry
 - One IT technician expert for the system.











Role of BoCTs


What are we going to supply to The Regional Bureau of Culture and Tourism

- 1. Initial training to System Users and System Technicians (done)
- 2. Assistance during the start up of the system (mission 1)
- 3. Assistance to engagement of local Stakeholders (mission 1 and 2):
- 4. Assistance to direct survey on domestic tourists (mission 1, 2 and 3);
- 5. Advanced training on data management (September);
- 6. Advanced training on communication (September);
- 7. Equipment from ESTDP (Procurement).













Role of BoCTs

Assistance to BoCTs

- 1. Three missions during the last part of the project;
- 2. First mission:
 - meeting with the local managers of the Statistic System
 - training of local Accommodation Facilities Employees
 - planning of surveys on tourists (location and dates)
 - assistance during the first survey on tourists;
 - · planning of next activities.
- 3. Second mission:
 - · check of the activity done;
 - · engagement of Stakeholders
- 4. Third mission:
 - · follow up of the activity done
 - organization for the future











Role of BoCTs

Assistance to BoCTs: the first mission

- 1. When: starting from next week
- 2. Who: local team of experts and participants at the training in Addis Ababa May $13^{\rm th}-15^{\rm th}$ IF NO OTHER ASSIGNED
- 3. How: local team contacts the participants and together organize activities;
- **4. Which activity**: updated data base of Accommodation Facilities; training of local Accommodation Facilities, first survey on Domestic Tourism
- **5.** Plus: organization of the office (who does what), list of equipment needed.











Role of BoCTs

Assistance to BoCTs: focus on training of Employees of Accommodation Facilities

- **1.** Cascade principle **1.**: first training of Accommodation Facilities of Capital Cities. Fast organization and no travel costs.
- 2. Duration: session of maximum two hours. No costs for lunch.
- **3. Venue**: small groups, maximum 20 attendees, may be that in some BoCTs' headquarter there is a room like this. Low costs for venues.
- $\textbf{4. Organization:} \ we \ suggest \ engagement \ of \ local \ Hotel \ Associations.$
- **5.** Cascade principle 2.: training in other cities managed directly from the local BoCTs (Tigray and Amhara with local staff representative).
